APPROPRIATE DRESS -

Knowing what to wear is always a challenge. To help you, here are four categories of clothing you will need. Appropriate dress is expected as follows:

	Casual	Professional Casual	Semi-formal
For guys	Jeans, khakis, t-shirts, tennis shoes. Does not include cut-offs or worn jeans with holes.	Slacks, shirts without ties, dress shoes, boots, clean tennis shoes.	Dress slacks with a shirt and tie, jacket or sweater, leather shoes, boots. No athletic shoes.
For girls	Jeans, khakis, t-shirts, tennis shoes. Does not include cut-offs or worn jeans with holes.	Skirts* or slacks with an appropriate blouse or shirt. Dress denim (denim skirts* and pressed jeans) and khakis are appropriate. Clean tennis shoes are allowed.	Dresses*, suits, with skirts* or dress slacks, blouses, leather shoes. No denim clothing or athletic shoes.

*(4" above the knee or longer)

The following chart will help you know what is appropriate for each activity. Appropriate dress is critical. Anyone not well-groomed and following dress rules will be requested to return to the dormitory to dress appropriately.

Tuesday	Travel to LSU	Casual
Tuesday	Free time on campus	Casual
Tuesday	Evening Assembly	Casual – suggested attire Purple & Gold
Wednesday/ Thursday	Contests	Professional casual, as specified by the superintendent or casual depending on format of the contest.
Wednesday/ Thursday	Educational Program	Professional casual or casual.
Wednesday/ Thursday	Free time on campus	Casual
Wednesday	Evening Assembly	Professional Casual – Parish Pride Night
Thursday	Evening Assembly	Semi-formal
Friday	Travel home	Casual
