Cancellations will not be accepted. However, a substitution of a non-registered participant for registered participant can be made. Please notify the LSU AgCenter if there is a cancellation.

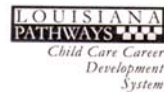

What You Need to Know to Attend a Child Care Class

If you plan to participate in an AgCenter sponsored child care provider training class, you will need to pre-register and send in a money order at least 5 days prior to the day of the class. A minimum number of 10 registered participants are required to teach a class. If there are less than 10 pre-registered for a class, it will be cancelled. You will be given credit to attend another LSU AgCenter class or your money order will be returned.

The maximum number allowed in a class depends on the size of the room where the class is being held. For most classes, the maximum is 35. To make sure you have a place in the class remember to pre-register and send in a money order made payable to "LSU AgCenter."

Don't forget that you must be on time for each class to receive full credit for the class. Plan ahead and arrive early if needed. There will always be coffee, punch and snacks available when you arrive. You may bring your own light refreshments as well.
