

“Character Counts” Poster

1. Open to any 4-H club member.
2. Divisions for this contest are: Elementary - (grades 4-5)
Junior - (grades 6-8)
Senior - (grades 9-12)
3. Poster must be on 11" x 14" poster board. Posters must not have brand names listed on them or have anything thicker than 1/8" glued to them.
4. All posters receive a ribbon. First through third place division winners receive a rosette ribbon. First and second place winners in each division will receive monetary awards of \$10 and \$5 respectively. The awards will be presented at the end-of-the- year recognition program. Senior overall winners will be eligible for 4-H University.
5. All posters must have the contestant's **name, address, grade, 4-H club** and **school name** on the back in the upper right hand corner.
6. Posters should not be "rolled". Please leave them flat.

Theme for the contest should be to make the public aware of Character Education through the “Character Counts” program. Also National “Character Counts” week is in October. The poster should include at least one or all of the six pillars of character. They are trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and citizenship.
