## C.R.D. Club Contest

"CRD" Club contest - (CRD stands for community and resource development.) Club CRD books are due on May 1.

Materials in the record book must cover the period from June 1, of the previous year to May 30 of the current 4-H club year.

The winner in each division at Parish will compete at state level in July.

The report should be organized as follows:

1. Basic information about the club -- name, enrollment, age range of members.
2. CRD Summary.
3. One activity report completed for each CRD activity conducted.

The report should include only one fact sheet about the club and one activity report for each activity.

The report should be assembled in a sturdy, loose leaf (8 1/2" x 11") binder. The 4-H record book cover is ideal. PLEASE DO NOT USE ANY OTHER SIZE BOOK. Do not include pictures, news articles or other supporting material.

**Evaluation of the CRD Contest will be as follows:**

- 1. Community Service Activities  
(Examples: safety campaigns, clean up campaign, service to senior citizens)
    - A. Planning Process ..... 25 points
      - (1) Who was involved?
      - (2) How many planning sessions were held?
      - (3) Were committees appointed?
      - (4) Committee responsibilities
    - B. Execution..... 25 points
      - (1) Who was involved in the project execution?
      - (2) Description of project
      - (3) Results
      - (4) What did 4-H'ers learn from project?
  
  - 2. Community Study Activities  
(Examples: tours of fire stations, jails, courtroom, guest speakers such as mayors, civic leaders, etc., studies of your community history or heritage.)
    - A. Planning Process ..... 25 points
      - (1) Who was involved?
      - (2) How many planning sessions were held?
      - (3) Were committees appointed?
      - (4) Committee responsibilities
    - B. Execution..... 25 points
      - (1) Who was involved in the project execution?
      - (2) Description of project
      - (3) Results
      - (4) What did 4-H'ers learn from project?
