Please return the permission slip to the 4-H Office by October 21, 2009. We need to make sure we have at least 16 people to attend.

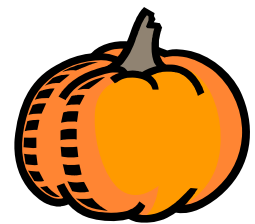

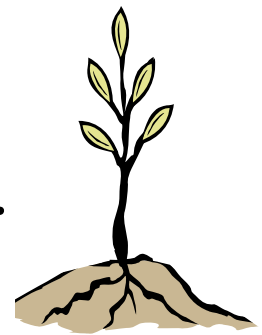

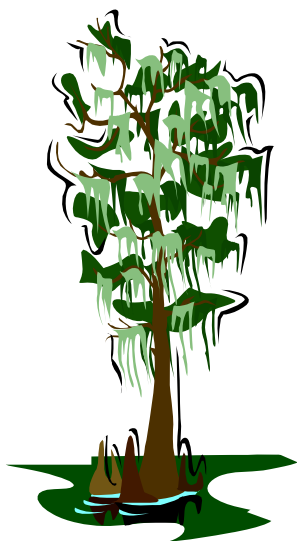
Pennies for Plants

Parish Wide Service Project



4-H The Original Green is the name of the state wide 4-H Service Learning Project Initiative. There are many service projects that 4-H Clubs can organize around the "GO GREEN" theme. In St. Bernard "GOING GREEN" means planting trees. There is an effort in St. Bernard to plant 100,000 trees to replace those lost in Hurricane Katrina. 4-H members have decided to join this effort because members feel that trees are important to our area because they add beauty to the parish and protect our community from hurricane winds and storm surge.

In order to involve all 4-H Clubs in the tree planting, high school members have come up with the idea of "Pennies for Plants". We would like for each 4-H Club to come up with a way to raise \$200.00 which will be used to purchase 1,000 Cypress seedlings. Some ideas for raising money include \$1.00 for free dress, selling paper cypress trees or a penny drive. If schools raise more that \$200.00 they can purchase more that 1,000 trees.



4-H Clubs can identify where at their school a few cypress trees can be planted in January or February. The remainder of the trees purchased by a school will be donated by that club to a larger tree planting. Students from Chalmette High School will plant the remaining trees in lower St. Bernard Parish. We will also have a parish wide planting day where 4-H Club Members and their families can join us to plant Cypress Trees.
