This summer youth enrichment program will employ 16 to 18 year old students at various jobs during their summer break. The program will employ two 4-H members and one non-4-H member from each police jury district. This program will not only provide a valuable first employment experience, but also focus on the development of financial management skills and workforce ethics. J.E.T. will begin on June 29, 2009, and run through July 31, 2009. All educational programs will be under the direction of Mrs. Diane Uzzle, Financial Resource Management Agent and Elizabeth Lynn, 4-H Youth Development Agent. All applications must be turned in at the Police Jury office no later than Wednesday, April 20, 2009, by 4:00 p.m.. Applications will be reviewed and telephone notification will follow on April 21-24, 2009, to set up the interview schedule. Interviews will take place on April 28 for Police Jury Districts 1, 2, 3 and on April 29 for Districts 4 & 5, and April 30 for Districts 6 & 7. Successful applicants will be notified May 1.
