

## HOW TO REGISTER

*Money orders only should be made payable to: LSU AgCenter*

### Registration

Advance registration is required for all sessions. Completed mail in registration forms accompanied with non-refundable money orders will be accepted. These will be accepted no later than 5 days prior to the session. This allows the trainers to prepare adequately for each session.

**There must be a minimum of 10 paid participants to conduct a class. The maximum in a class is 30.**

**Once that number is reached, no further participants will be accepted.**

### Arrival Time

Participants should arrive promptly and be prepared for class to start at scheduled time. Late arrival will result in less than 3 hours credit for class.

### Cancellations

Cancellations will not be accepted. However, a substitution of a non-registered participant for registered participant can be made.

### Payment

- \$7.50 per person per class for Class A and Registered Providers for 3 hours (\$42.50 for Class B)
- \$10 per person per class for Class A and Registered Providers for the 4 hour class (\$45 for Class B)
- we only accept money orders
- money orders are non-refundable

## Fall Activities



Play is a critical part of everyday for young children. Children learn important concepts and explore the world around them through play. Fall is a fun time to plan outside activities or bring the outdoors inside.

### Fall Sorting

Materials: 3 egg cartons, 12 acorns, 12 pinecones, 12 leaves, or other fall objects, small container.

Description: Place objects in small container on table. Encourage children to sort the objects into the egg cartons.

### Fall Leaves Place Mats

Materials: Contact paper, leaf patterns, crayons suitable for “rubbing” in fall colors and white construction paper.

Description: Tape the leaf cutouts on the table. Place construction paper over the cutouts. Have the children rub the crayon colors of their choice over several of the leaf patterns. Cover front (and back if you choose) with contact paper. These are very bright and colorful.

### Fall Poem

Red and yellow, green and brown.

*(count off colors on fingers)*

Leave are falling to the ground.

*(simulate falling leaves with hands)*

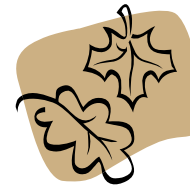
We pile them up OH SO HIGH:
