## State Fair Information

For more information on the State Fair of Louisiana go to their website [www.statefairoflouisiana.com](http://www.statefairoflouisiana.com). Exhibitors that do not have computer access may call the livestock office at 318-635-1361.

The 2009 State Fair in Shreveport is just around the corner. Based on the fall show entry forms you returned, your animal(s) have already been entered in the State Fair and entry fees have been paid.

Following is information about the Fair that you need to be aware of. Please read carefully.

1. **School excuses** will be mailed out one week prior to the show. However, please be reminded that it is the responsibility of the child and the parents to inform teachers, to check with the school office to see if the excuse has arrived, and to make sure the child is officially excused **before** any days are missed. Exhibitors are also expected to make up any school work missed during their absence.
2. All animals are required to have **health papers** accompany them to the Fair. The Louisiana Department of Agriculture will be checking health papers as you enter the gate. Each exhibitor is required to secure his/her own. If you have not taken care of this, please contact your veterinarian as soon as possible.
3. **(A)** All registration papers were to be submitted directly to the State Fair by **September 7**. This would include **Beef breeding, dairy breeding and breeding sheep**. If this has not been taken care of, contact the State Fair office directly to work out the details. **(B)** Furthermore, you will be required to check in your **original** papers yourself when you arrive at the Fair.
4. **Market animal** exhibitors: We have been informed that any market animal ear tag that has fallen out, been torn out, or removed must be reported at the scale.
5. Anyone wishing to try for the **Louisville trip** must complete a trip application at the Fair and turn it in before the start of their respective show.
7. As the Fair approaches, travel plans and excuses from school must be arranged. Check the schedule of events sent earlier. Group transportation is certainly a good idea.
8. A copy of the schedule is attached for your information. Please become familiar with the schedule for your specie/breed.

## Livestock Information

The State Livestock Show 2010 Schedule of Events has not yet been posted. Once the state show office personnel notifies us that it's been posted, we will in turn notify you.

Release time for each of the Fall Shows is indicated on each schedule. **You are expected to abide by these times.** If you have a problem with any of these, please tell us so that we can recommend to the respective show managements that changes be made for the future.

We must have a copy of the registration papers of all **breeding** animals before the animals may attend a show. Many of you have already taken care of this; but if not, you **must get a copy to us immediately.**

**ALL** animals are required to have health papers accompany them to any show. Each exhibitor is required to secure his/her own. Contact your veterinarian.

Please bring whatever equipment (rakes, shovels, clippers, blowers, etc.) you will need with you to the shows.

Those of you needing directions to the festivals may contact our office. We will mail directions only upon request.

Remember, all fall festival exhibitors, **it is your responsibility to check in once you arrive at the upcoming shows.** Please **bring your original registration papers along with you to all shows.**

## Closing Remarks

Make sure that you join 4-H at your school and enroll in the appropriate livestock projects. Even though you were a member and were enrolled in the livestock projects last year, you **MUST** fill out another enrollment card and select your livestock project for the coming year.

If you know of any first year enrollees who plan to exhibit livestock and do not receive this newsletter, please inform them of the enrollment process and/or let us know so we can make sure they are on our mailing list.

# 2009 SUGARCANE 4-H LIVESTOCK SHOW AND SALE

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Louisiana Sugarcane Festival and Fair Association will not provide feed for livestock nor be responsible for their feeding and general care. Each exhibitor of livestock should have someone in the SugArena to care for his/her project.

1. Exhibits will be accepted only from bonafide residents of recognized sugarcane parishes of Louisiana. Recognized sugarcane parishes are: Acadia, Allen, Ascension, Assumption, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Cameron, Calcasieu, East Baton Rouge, E. Feliciana, Evangeline, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Lafourche, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, Rapides, St. Charles, St. Helena, St. James, St. John, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Terrebonne, Vermilion, Vernon, Washington, West Baton Rouge, and W. Feliciana.
2. Exhibitors, when registering, should show their proper mailing address and also the parish in which they live.
3. Exhibitors will not be allowed to bring exhibits not entered in show.
4. All livestock entries should be filed with the Iberia 4-H agent by **September 2, 2009**. **ENTRIES RECEIVED BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 3-9 WILL BE ACCEPTED BUT ENTRY FEES WILL DOUBLE (\$20.00 PER ANIMAL) ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER SEPTEMBER 9<sup>TH</sup>**
5. All livestock must be in place by the times on the printed schedule.
6. Judging will take place Thursday, September 24, Friday, September 25, and Saturday, September 26, 2009.
7. No individual will be permitted to make more than one entry under any class number in any department, *with the exception of Class N (market lambs), Class P (market goats) and Class O (commercial heifers)*
8. Competition in the Junior Division of the Agricultural Fair is open to all youths in the sugarcane producing parishes who have not reached their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the first day of the Fair. All exhibitors must comply with the general rules and special rules for each division in which they compete. All exhibits must be the products or property of the exhibitor. Open livestock exhibitors must be bonafide 4-H or FFA members.
9. The Louisiana Sugarcane Festival and Fair Association, the Iberia Parish Government, SugArena at Acadiana Fairgrounds, the Iberia Cattlemen's Association, the Louisiana Cooperative Extension Service LSU AgCenter and 4-H volunteers/leaders will take every precaution to insure safety of all exhibits, but in no case shall be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any character, from any cause to such property while same is at livestock exhibit or in transit to and from the livestock facility.
10. Any exhibit removed prior to the official release time, without the superintendent's permission, will be automatically disqualified, and no premium will be awarded, even though the exhibit placed.
11. The livestock events officially close Saturday afternoon, September 26, 2009 at the conclusion of the livestock sale. All livestock must be removed by 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.
12. Watchmen will be provided from 11:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. Thursday and Friday night.
13. The records in Judge's books will be the final basis on which all premiums will be awarded.
14. For all other rules not listed above the most current year's edition of the LSU AgCenter's livestock show catalog/rule book will be used.

Note: Sheep and goat pens are available on a limited basis; therefore the Sugarcane 4-H livestock show is a “show and go” type of event for 4-H exhibitors in these open events.

Note: All “open” livestock exhibitors may arrive after 5:00 a.m. on Thursday but must be in place prior to their shows as stated in the schedule.

ABBEVILLE, LA • OCTOBER 9-10, 2009

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Breeding animals will be limited to registered stock and registration papers must be shown upon making an entry. Registration papers must be in the name of exhibitor. An exhibitor may show only one animal per class.
2. All dairy heifers regardless of age, that have freshened, will show in the two year old cow classes.
3. All entries must remain on exhibition until released by an official of the festival, otherwise premium will be forfeited.
4. No one will be permitted to sleep in the exhibit barn from opening to closing of festival. A night watchman will be provided Friday night only.
5. Adults will not be allowed to show animals in Louisiana Cattle Festival.
6. All animals must arrive between 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. FRIDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2009.
7. Sheep and goats will be released FRIDAY, OCTOBER 9, as they finish showing. Dairy will be released Saturday at noon. Beef will be released SATURDAY, OCTOBER 10, after judging is completed. All animals must be out of barn by 6:00 p.m. SATURDAY.
8. Premium money for Breeding Classes: 1st place - \$10.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> place - \$8.00; 3rd place - \$6.00; 4th place - \$4.00; 5th place - \$2.00.
9. In classes where champions are selected, the winner will receive a trophy. Reserve champion will receive a rosette.
10. Any beef breed which had 10 or more entries the previous year will be allowed to show as a separate breed.
11. Beef breeding classes will be broken down as they are for the current years Louisiana State Fair.
12. Market steers will compete as prospect steers (under 950 lbs.) and market steers (950 lbs. and over).
13. Cash prizes for Jackpot Market Lamb and Goat Show will be based on number of entries.
14. Market lambs are over 99 lbs. and prospect lambs are considered 99 lbs. and under.
15. No dogs will be allowed in barn!
