Dear Exhibitor:

Our records show that you have joined 4-H and enrolled in the horse project. By doing so, you have indicated to us that you plan to show a horse during the summer horse shows in June 2009.

Entry forms for these shows were mailed to you the first week in April and were to be returned to us by April 15<sup>th</sup>. Thus far we have received nothing from you. **IF WE FAIL TO HEAR FROM YOU BY Wednesday, April 30<sup>th</sup>**, we will assume you will not be showing at the summer shows and we will not accept any entries after this date without a written excuse.

Some of you have indicated the reason for not returning entry forms is due to registration papers pending. If this is the case, return the entry, the horse I.D. form, the fees and a note stating that the papers are pending.

If you have any questions, please contact Mr. Charles at 291-7090, and remember, **WE WILL ACCEPT NO ENTRIES AFTER APRIL 30<sup>th</sup>** without a written excuse. If you fail to complete your paperwork by this date, you will have to submit a written excuse to the Horse Advisory Committee by May 10<sup>th</sup>. The Committee will determine the amount of late entry fees.
