3. Cake must be either: a 13" x 9" sheet cake or two 8" or 9" rounds.
4. All contestants must attend an educational program while dishes are being judged.
5. Bring (2) copies of your recipe to the contest. One recipe should have your name on it and one recipe should *not*.

# Recipe Evaluation Centennial Birthday Cake Cookery Contest

## Recipe Evaluation

The recipe will be evaluated based on the following information:

- A. Name of the recipe given
- B. Ingredients listed in order used in instructions
- C. Include size and weight of cans, packages, etc.  
(Ex. 1 - 8 oz package of cream cheese)
- D. Clear instructions
- E. Size of pan stated
- F. Temperature and cooking times stated
- G. Number of servings given
- H. Dish meets contest and division requirements
