Other Opportunities at 4-H U – explore LSU Campus (swimming, athletics); evening assemblies and dances and movies; run for a state or district level 4-H Officer position (requires early entry form). 4-H U is a bargain - \$50 covers the cost of room, transportation, insurance, 4-H U fees; participants bring enough money for food and other (personal) expenses for three days, three nights, and a “wake up.” Contest participants not able to stay on Campus may compete on the day of their contests. 4-H'ers must notify Agents of their interest in 4-H U by May 1 and submit \$50 fee and permission form, soon thereafter.
