

## HOW TO REGISTER

**Class Descriptions:**

**Fun in the Sun--** Learn how to stay sun-safe when outdoors. What is required protection for providers and for children in their care? This lesson includes precautions to take when outdoors and activities for children when the heat is on.

**Children's Temperaments: Flexible, Fearful or Feisty**—Children's temperament should be taken into consideration in how they are guided. An understanding of temperamental differences can help caregivers work more responsively and effectively with individual infants and toddlers in their care. Each child has his or her own unique blend of temperament traits

**Dealing with Difficult Situations--**Caregivers will be introduced to recommended practices and skills which will create a nurturing environment for children in their care.

**Cooking with Kids**—Learn fun ways to explore nutrition through simple cooking activities with children.

**Together in Care: Creating Partnerships with Parents**—Both parent and caregiver should see their relationship as a partnership to enhance the care of their child. A partnership allows them to share each others special knowledge in order to expand their personal understanding of the child and find ways to meet the child's needs.

**Character Critters**—Want your children to respect and care for others? In this session you will learn the 6 pillars of character: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, citizenship, and caring. Each childcare provider will receive educational materials to implement the program.
