

HOW TO REGISTER

Money orders only should be made payable to: LSU AgCenter

Registration: Classes fill up rapidly! Advance registration is required for all sessions. Only completed mail in registration forms accompanied with non-refundable money orders will be accepted. These will be accepted no later than **5 days** prior to the session. This allows the trainers to prepare adequately for each session.

There must be a minimum of 10 participants to conduct a class. The maximum in a class is 20. Once that number is reached, no further participants will be accepted.

Cancellations:

Cancellations will not be accepted. However, a substitution of a non-registered participant for registered participant can be made.

Follow Safety Tips To Ensure Summertime Fun

Summer is here, and outdoor play ranks as a favorite activity for most young children. But that means safety also should be a concern for parents and caregivers.

Summertime gives children the opportunity to use and develop their large muscles while running, climbing, skipping, hopping, throwing, catching, digging, riding bikes and swimming. While outdoor play is a favorite for children, parents and caregivers must be aware that outdoor injuries are the leading cause of injuries to young children.

Experts say parents and caregivers should pay particularly close attention to the outdoor areas in which children play and the weather conditions they are playing in.

Planning and supervision are the keys to keeping children safe while outdoors. Approximately 40 percent of the outdoor injuries to children are due to poor adult supervision. Choosing a safe environment for play is extremely important.

Sun exposure can be hazardous to children – particularly in Louisiana. Consider the following sun safe tips for the protection of yourself and your children:

- Stay out of the sun between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Choose and apply a sunscreen with a sun protection factor (SPF) of 15 or higher. Apply sunscreen liberally at least 30 minutes prior to going outdoors, and reapply often.
- Wear hats or caps that protect the head and face from the sun
- Shaded areas should be available to children
- Water should be available to children at all times when playing outdoors.
